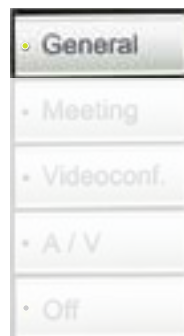
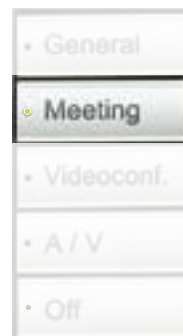

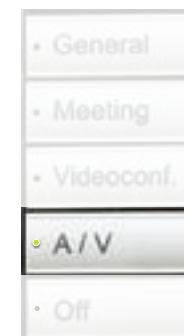
Conference rooms demand flexible control in order to accommodate a number of activities. Adjust shades and lights for roundtable discussions, presentations, and even cleanup.



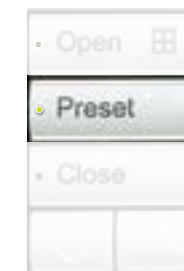
Shades are open to allow daylight in, brightening the room to energize the staff for a morning meeting. The lights by the window are dimmed to save energy.



Silently lower sheer shades to reduce glare and solar heat gain, while preserving the view in this west-facing conference room. The lights put the focus on the table for an afternoon meeting.



Blackout shades lower through side channels to completely block daylight. General light levels are set low to ensure maximum visibility of the screen with enough light for note-taking.



Multiple shade and drape groups can be controlled independent of scenes with the GRAFIK Eye® QS.
